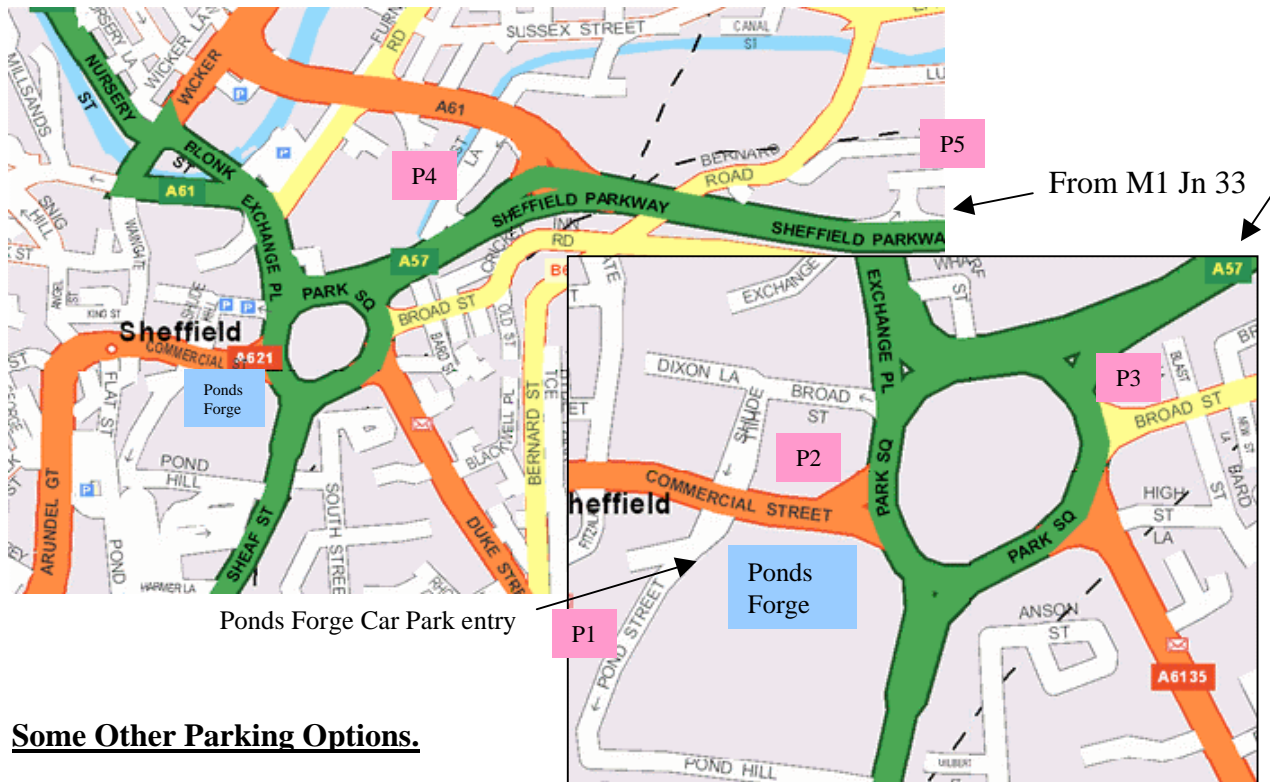


## Sheffield Ponds Forge, Sheaf St, Sheffield, S1 2BP – Tel: 0114 279 9766.

From the M1 Junction 33, head towards Sheffield on the ‘Sheffield Parkway’. This starts as the A630, and becomes the A57. When you reach the Park Square roundabout, Ponds Forge is directly opposite. Head towards the last exit off the roundabout and then turn immediately left onto Broad St. Turn left again into Shude Hill. This road goes under Commercial St, and becomes Pond Street. Ponds Forge Car park is on the left as Pond Street starts. This Car Park gets full very quickly. It costs £1.35 per 3 hours but **you must get your ticket stamped at reception** to get this rate. Otherwise it is nearly £7.00 per 3 hours.



### Some Other Parking Options.

- P1. On road Pay & display on Pond Street is £1.35 per hour with a max stay of 1 hour.
- P2. Pay & display parking on the left of Broad Street. It costs £1.10 per hour with a max stay of 6 hours.
- P3. Pay & display parking off Broad St on Blast lane. (1<sup>st</sup> exit after the Sheffield parkway off the park sq roundabout) This has various tariffs up to £5 per day. There is a pedestrian overpass to Commercial St.
- P4. North Quay car park at Victoria Quays, costs £3 for up to a day. Approach by car from the Parkway. Pay on exit (exact coinage required). It would take about 10 mins to walk to Ponds Forge from there. (Go past the Hilton Hotel)
- P5. Park & ride at Nunnery Sq. which costs £3 a day. From there you would catch a tram to the Ponds Forge stop which is on Commercial Street. Unlimited tram travel for 1 for a day is included in the cost. Additional fares would be £1 for a single or £2.70 for a “dayrider”. The journey is 5 minutes. Trams are approx every 20 mins.
- P6. The serious shopper option. You can park for free at Meadowhall shopping centre (near M1 Junction 34), & catch a tram. The tram journey from Meadowhall is less than 20 mins. The single fare is £1.70, though the dayrider is probably the option to go for.
